Ski Engelberg The resort offers skiing on both sides of its valley. The smaller, sunnier Brunni area is served by a cable-car from just outside town and offers a selection of mostly short, tree-lined intermediate pistes. On the other side of the valley, Engelberg's larger Titlis area is also served by lifts from just outside town. This is where you will find the bulk of the more challenging terrain (both on and off-piste) that the resort is famous for. Ski runs top out at 10,000 feet.

Ski Engelberg... The storied village of Engelberg sits high on the northern front of the Swiss Alps, being the first to catch the moisture of the storms as they roll in from the Atlantic. There are two main areas of ski slopes: the delightful south facing Brunni area which features tree lined intermediate trails, and Engelberg's larger Titlis area across the valley, where you will find the bulk of the more challenging terrain (both on and off-piste). The Titlis area can be split into two distinct sectors, the first being Trübsee-Stand-Titlis which has the glacier and a vertical drop of nearly 2000m. The Jochpass sector is smaller, but also of interest to both on and off-piste skiers.

Brussels and Bruges.....Brussels is the capital of Belgium, Flanders and Europe. The Medieval Grand-Place, is indeed grand, with many 17th-century buildings and daily flower markets. Reopened in 2006, the Atomium, Brussels' Eiffel Tower, provides great views, inside and out. Your hotel for three nights is the four-star Novatel Brussels Off Grand Place, just steps from what is described as the most beautiful town square in the world. This location is just a few easy steps to many restaurants and bars. You can walk to many major sites and attractions in just 15 minutes, including famous museums, the Midi Station, Parc de Bruxelles, Royal Palace and Place du Grand Sablon. The medieval city of **Bruges**, is the capital of West Flanders in northwest Belgium. It is distinguished by its canals, cobbled streets and medieval buildings. Its port, Zeebrugge, is an important center for fishing and European trade. In the city center's Burg Square, the 14th-century Stadhuis (City Hall) has an ornate carved ceiling. Nearby, Market Square features a 13th-century belfry with a 47-bell carillon and 83m tower with paparamic views.
