#### Selva Val Gardena

This region of Italy, South Tyrol, was actually part of Austria until the end of World War One. Val Gardena boasts as many as 300 sunny days a year. With modern ski facilities, well-groomed slopes and even a "snow guarantee," the region provides fantastic skiing over a vast network of trails. The Dolomites are a UNESCO World Heritage Site, whose stunning beauty should be on every skiers bucket list. For passionate skiers, no ski holiday would be complete without conquering the "Sellaronda." This ski tour route circles the Sella Massif and is accompanied by spectacular Dolomite views. Val Gardena is also known for exquisite food, combining the unique Alpine characteristics of the South Tyrol region with the traditional Mediterranean cuisine. Our hotel in Selva Val Gardena is the delightful four-star Hotel Oswald. (Free shuttle in the morning to the lifts, ski back to the hotel in the afternoon.)

Innsbruck is the imperial capital of Austria's Tyrolian region. Coveted by empires and republics throughout its history, Innsbruck was the seat of the court of Maximilian I by the end of the 15th century. Explore the Tyrolean capital's history at Archduke Ferdinand II's 10th-century Schloss Ambras, the Tyrolean Folk Art Museum, the grand 15th-century Imperial Palace and Maximilian I's famous Golden Roof. One of Europe's most idyllic cities, Innsbruck is nestled in the heart of the Alps. YES, you can ski during our stay at one of six ski centers, including the "Hafelekar" Austria's steepest trail. The city is also the easy departure point for exploration of fabled cities such as Saltzburg and Munich. Your stay in Innsbruck is at the four star Hotel Innsbruck, just steps from the entrance to the Old City. You will enjoy a fascinating walking tour of the city, along with evening entertainment at a Folk Lore Night.
